Elranatamab Biosimilar – Anti-BCMA/CD3 Bispecific Antibody

Elranatamab is a bispecific T-cell engager (BCMA $\times$ CD3) immunotherapy used to treat relapsed or refractory multiple myeloma. For laboratory and scientific research purposes, elranatamab biosimilars or "benchmark" antibodies are widely available to test the drug's mechanism of action (MOA) and to use in cell assays or in-vivo.

Aliquots should be stored at the same temperature after first use to avoid multiple freeze-thaws Addition of 20 to 40 % glycerol may improve cryoprotection. Purified antibodies should ideally be stored as 0.5 to 2.0 mg/ml stock solutions. Aliquot the product according to your needs to avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
